General Information

EU citizens from other countries who live in Germany have the right to vote here in the European elections. To do this it is necessary to be listed in the German electoral roll. This flyer will provide all the necessary information on how to register for the election in Germany.

Please keep in mind that you can only elect the parties of the country you are voting in. If you vote in Germany, you can only vote for German parties running for the election. If you want to vote for one of the parties in your home country, you need to vote in the election there. Of course, to do that, you need to be registered in your home country for the election and not in Germany.

Please consult the official bodies in your home country for information on how to register for the European election there.

Requirements

There are three requirements you need to fulfil to be allowed to vote. You have to be:

1. 18 years old
2. an EU citizen for at least three months
3. and you must not have been excluded from the right to vote in Germany or in your home country.

How to register

You register for the German electoral roll by an application form. You can download this form from www.bundeswahlleiter.de, or use the provided QR-Code.



This form needs to be filled out and signed. The signed form has to be registered with the election team of the Bielefeld municipal administration by May 5th at the latest. The form can be sent by post or submitted personally at the local Bürgerberatung. You will find the postal address for Bielefeld at the end of this flyer.

The application form and the election voting card are provided only in German. If you need help to fill out the form, please ask a person you trust to help you. This person needs to sign the application form as an auxiliary person.

If you have been registered in the German electoral roll before, you do not need to register again. This is only needed if you have withdrawn your registration.
